

KNOW YOUR DO'S AND DON'TS

All parking restrictions identified by markings on the carriageway and/or signs will be enforced. As a rule, if you see a parking restriction marking on the carriageway you should look for a nearby sign which will tell you what the restriction is and when it applies.

THE MAIN ON-STREET RESTRICTIONS ARE...



Double yellow lines Mean no waiting at any time. There is no need for a sign with these lines as they apply all the time. Loading and unloading is permitted on this restriction.



A single yellow line Means exactly the same as the double yellow line (i.e. No Waiting) during the times shown on the nearby sign (8.30am – 6.15pm). Loading and unloading is permitted on this restriction.



A parking bay Marking plus the adjacent white sign means the same as a broken yellow line. In Dungannon you can park for a maximum of 60 minutes. On leaving you are not allowed to return to that location for at least 2 hours. This applies between 8.30am and 6.15pm from Monday to Saturday. If no signs are in place with this road marking, there is no limitation on how long you can park.

A parking bay for Blue Badge Holders



This is designed to provide convenient parking and should never be used by any motorist not properly displaying a valid Blue Badge.



Bus Stops

It is illegal to park on Bus Stop markings at anytime, during the times shown on the nearby sign.



Loading Bay

It is illegal to park on Loading Bay markings at anytime. Parking reverts to limited waiting on Saturday as shown on the nearby sign.



PARKING TIPS

On street parking restrictions are designed to assist traffic flow and improve safety.

- Avoid parking in a loading bay. It is a traffic offence to disobey these restrictions
- When using a public car park or on street car parking space always park in the designated parking bays
- Leave disabled parking bays for people with disabilities
- Avoid leaving valuable items visible in parked cars
- Show consideration. Do not park your vehicle in a way that would inconvenience other road users or pedestrians
- Do not park where you are likely to cause an obstruction to private entrances/ alleyways / footways
- Observe the waiting restrictions and read carefully the associated signs

The 60 second check

- Park in a secure and well lit location
- If you can, remove the stereo or at least the face of it
- Remove valuables and personal possessions
- Lock bulky items in the boot
- If you can, leave the glove compartment open to show that there is nothing of value in it
- Lock all windows and doors

Most importantly give yourself plenty of time to get parked to complete your shopping, and be patient with other shoppers and road users!
